GUIDELINES FOR BRA ART COMPETITION 2012

1. The competition is open to anyone residing in Fiji.
2. There are two categories for entries:
 - (a) Make a bra
 - (b) Decorate a bra
3. Entrants for the competition are classified in two age groups:
 - (a) Adult
 - (b) Junior (up to and including 15 yrs)
4. The Bra Art Committee, judges and their families may enter artwork for exhibition only.
5. A panel of judges will determine competition winners. The decision of the panel will be final and non-negotiable.
6. The first 100 entrants will receive a gift pack courtesy of Colgate Palmolive. All entries will be exhibited at various locations around the country during October.
7. All entries must be registered: **Part A** of the registration form should be pinned to the entry and **Part B** should be retained by entrants.
8. Entries must be packed in a cardboard box (eg shoe box) which should be clearly labelled with the entrant's name.
9. Please note that due to delivery and storage problems, bra entries larger than shoe box size may not be accepted.
10. Entrants may put in more than one entry; however each entry must be accompanied by a separate registration form and only one prize will be awarded per entrant.
11. Entries should be delivered to Westpac branches in Fiji or to the Fiji Cancer Society's office at the Tamavua Rehabilitation Hospital by Monday 15 October **at the latest**.

12. The judging will take place on Friday 19 October and winners will be notified as soon as possible thereafter. All entries will be displayed at locations to be announced.
13. Entrants who are not donating their artwork may collect it from the Fiji Cancer Society Office during the week beginning on Monday 5 November. Uncollected entries automatically become the property of the Fiji Cancer Society.
14. Artwork submitted for the competition should be original and should not be replicas of any bras exhibited previously. Bras should be made of non-perishable materials and be wearable.
15. Entrants are encouraged to give a title or dedication to their artwork.
16. The Bra Art Committee reserves the right to exclude any entry should it be deemed offensive.
17. The Fiji Cancer Society may use any bra entered for display or advertising purposes.
18. The Fiji Cancer Society will not be responsible for any loss, damage, or theft of entries.
